The Planning and Implementation Committee invite you to intimate that the Rev David Cameron, appointed as facilitator to the Cluster, will visit the three congregations on April 12th (Polmont) and 19th April (Redding and Westquarter and Laurieston)

The purpose of the visit is to answer any questions members of the congregation may still have regarding the process and the possible outcomes of the Congregational vote. The Committee recognise that some are disappointed and hurt at this direction of travel, however would urge all to find it in their hearts to vote positively for the Union and the future Ministry. A united congregation will foster a stronger local church and maintain a presence in helping people come to faith in knowing Jesus as their Lord and Saviour.
